120 - 140 Sq. ft./ltr. @ recommended DFT.

Drying Time

Surface Dry: 10-20 minutes, Touch Dry: 30 minutes & Hard Dry: Overnight. (In normal drying conditions). Minimum recoating time: 30-60 minutes.

Heat Resistant: 160 °C dry

Shelf Life

1 Year when stored in dry and cool conditions under shade.

Thinning: Thin the paint with drinking/soft water. Thinning is required for brush/spray application.

Cleaning: Clean all tools and equipment immediately after use with clean water.

SURFACE PREPARATION (New): Surface must be clean, dry, and free of wax, grease, oil, loose or peeling paint, and other foreign materials. Emery paper should be used to remove rusts, if any. Use of Rust Remover is a must in order to remove rusts completely.

REFINISH WORK (Previously coated): Conditions listed above should be strictly followed. Previously painted, glossy surfaces should be lightly sanded and special thinner should be used to remove rusts completely.

APPLICATION DATA

Stir well before use. Apply by brush, roller, air spray or airless spray. For details of spray equipment contact Papillon Paints Technical Services Department.

CAUTION

Do not use when humidity levels may cause surface condensation (maximum 85%), during rainy conditions or if temperatures are likely to fall below 5°C during application and drying. Protect from frost. For best results, ambient temperature is preferred.

Use only in well ventilated areas. In case of insufficient ventilation during spraying, wear suitable respiratory equipment. Do not breathe vapor / spray. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of sweet water and seek medical advice. Keep out of reach of children.
